- 1 single-reed woodwind instrument made of wood or plastic, usually black with silver keys.
- 3 oval-shaped brass instrument with 3 valves, usually lacquer or silver plated.
- 5 a small cylindrical instrument with a metal frame and 2 heads. The upper head is struck, the bottom head has metal strings stretched across it.
