


The Central Park School Faculty and Staff can create a free web page or site!



We will use a 'blank page' for the Design Theme because the pages will be posted as part of the Central Park School Website.




If you have more than one page in your site, you will need to create Links to go to those pages. Drag the Title or Paragraph icon to the page and type the name of the link. Highlight the word(s) with the mouse and choose the Link button.



There are many other types of items that you can add to your website. Be careful when allowing students to post Google Maps and YouTube video links... Students should not post maps to their homes or objectionable photos or videos.




Remember to press Close and then Logout (on the main account screen) each time so that others may not use your account.
